This test consists of six sections: (1) a speaking section in which you will record your reading of a passage in the target language presented on the screen, (2) a language structures section in which you will complete grammatical exercises in the target language, (3) a reading section in which you will read a passage in the target language and write a response in English based on your comprehension of the passage, (4) a multiple-choice section in which you will read passages in the target language and respond to reading comprehension questions presented on the screen, and you will also respond to questions on language acquisition, instruction, and assessment, (5) a cultural understanding section in which you will write a response in English to an assignment on a target language related cultural topic, and (6) a writing assignment in which you will translate English sentences into the target language. The directions for each section appear immediately before that section.

For sections containing multiple-choice questions, read each question and answer choice carefully, and choose the ONE best answer. You should answer all questions. Even if you are unsure of an answer, it is better to guess than not to answer a question at all.
