Language Structures Section Directions

This section of the test requires you to demonstrate your command of the structures and usage of the Latin language. Directions are provided before each part. Your responses will be scored on the basis of grammatical correctness and sociolinguistic appropriateness.

Please note that special characters (such as letters with macrons or other diacritical marks) cannot be entered using the keyboard but are available for insertion in the on-

screen response box. To access these characters, click on the button that appears in the upper left corner of the screen. Using the mouse, click on the character you wish to include in your response and then select "Insert." The character will be inserted where the cursor is positioned in the response box.

Macrons are optional and will not be counted in scoring, regardless of whether you use them. You may use "i" and "j" interchangeably and "u" and "v" interchangeably; you need not be consistent in your use of these letters.

Your responses to the language structures exercise will be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

Grammar: Part A (1–12): Supplying the grammatically correct item

Transformation: Part B (13–16): Making a specified transformation

Correction: Part C (17–20): Correcting errors
